
Communication

Daily Check In


- "How was ____?"

 The importance of habitual agenda use cannot be overstated


• Students should fill in all sections of the agenda - 1 for each class - EVERY day

Contacting Teachers

Students should take the reins on contacting their teachers!

Email is convenient and easy through Canvas:

- Ask questions when you're checking grades
- Remember: Check to see if they respond
