# Arrival

At 8:15, the front gates will open for walkers, bike riders, and bus students. The car circle doors open at 8:15 and students can begin exiting cars once staff is on duty. Once students arrive on campus, they can go to breakfast, in the cafeteria, or head out to the PE Court (grades I-5) or the KG building (KG only) until the bell rings a 8:35. At 8:35, students will head to their classrooms.

<u>A few reminders for arrival:</u>

- Families are not allowed on campus to walk students to class. This is for the safety of our students.
- Students should not arrive on campus before 8:15. There is no supervision.
- Do not park and walk up at the car circle. Students will only exit vehicles in the car loop for their safety.
- Crossing guards and staff are on duty to help students cross our entrances to campus and the parking lots.
- Cars should not park in the north parking lot and walk students up. Please use car line.
- Building 6 parking lot is for Pre-K and ASD student arrival and dismissal only.
- Pre-K and ASD siblings can be dropped at building 6 to walk up to the front gate.
- Buses and day care vans drop off in bus loop only.

# Dismissal

Students are dismissed on a staggered schedule: first walkers and bike riders, then car riders, finally daycare vans and buses. This is done to assure the safety of all students. Car riders will wait in the cafeteria. Bus students will be called to exit the front of campus, Walkers and bike riders are dismissed to the front of campus as well.

A few reminders for dismissal:

- Do not park and walk up at the car circle. Students will only enter vehicles in the car loop for their safety.
- Display your car tags in your front window! This is the key to a smoother processdisplay every day until you are exiting the car line. We use them twice throughout the car line to get your child to their numbered spot for pick up.
- Crossing guards and staff are on duty to help students exit campus (at crosswalks and parking lots).
- Cars should not park in the north parking lot and walk to pick up students. Please use car line. It is the safest way to pick up.
- Building 6 parking lot is for Pre-K and ASD student dismissal only.
- Siblings of Pre-K students will be dismissed to building 6. Please wait in front of building 6 or in your car in the parking lot.
- Buses and day care vans pick up in bus loop only. Students are only called if the van/bus has arrived.

## Reminders:

- Label all backpacks, lunch boxes, jackets. and water bottles. If you are missing one, have your child check the lost and found in the cafeteria.
- Please call the office before 2:00 if you need to change the way your child goes home.
