

### College Course Placement

(based on qualifying test scores on ANY of the following tests)

Scores that may be used for placement **must be under two years old.**

SPC uses the highest scores from the PERT, ACT, and SAT administered within the last two years.

DE = Dual Enrollment – Qualifying scores needed only in the subject area of chosen course

ECP = Early College Program – Qualifying scores needed in all areas

EA = Early Admissions – Qualifying scores needed in all areas

<b>PERT</b>	<b>Reading subtest*</b>	<b>104+</b>	*Reading and Writing scores permit entry into college courses that are reading/writing based such as Composition I and/or courses with the following prefixes: ENC, PSY, AMH, ECO, HUM, PHI, POS, SYG, SPC, etc.

<b>SAT **</b>	<b>Critical Reading**</b>	<b>440+</b>	<b>**SAT or ACT scores may be used IN PLACE OF PERT scores.</b>

<b>ACT **</b>	<b>English**</b>	<b>17+</b>	SAT or ACT math scores permit entry into MAT 1033 Intermediate Algebra ONLY. Any math course beyond MAT 1033 requires an appropriate score on the Accuplacer College Level Math test (see above).
