EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION



DCF approved course used to obtain the Florida Staff Credential Early Childhood Professional Certification (ECPC) for childcare personnel/preschool teachers, which includes the DCF introductory childcare training parts one and two (40) clock hours). This course is recommended for students new to the early childhood education field. Students who successfully complete this program are also eligible to apply for the National CDA. This course is 600 hours, which includes 120 hours of instruction and 480 hours of direct work experience with children 5 years old or younger.
