ELECTRICIAN (BAY AREA ELECTRICAL)



The mission of this Apprenticeship program is to provide apprentices with the technical training to secure and maintain employment in the electrical field of work. BAEA is designed for any *employee* currently working as an electrician (or as an electrician's apprentice/helper), any *person* looking to obtain work as an electrician, and any *employer* looking to provide instruction for their electrician/apprentice (currently under the supervision of a licensed electrician). Topics covered include:

1st Year – Basic Electrical Theory – Residential Wiring

2nd Year – Advanced Electrical Theory – Commercial Wiring

3rd Year – Control Wiring – Programmable Logic Control

4th Year – Advanced NEC Studies – PCCLB Journeyman Testing

DETAILS

4 YRS – Full four-year program provides State Certificate of Completion and PCCLB acceptance for Journeyman Testing

- FLORIDA STATE ACCREDITED PROGRAM – Utilizes On-the-Job Training (OJT) and Scholastic Training (On-Campus)
- TUITION – Free for pre-approved apprentices
- PREREQUISITES – Must be currently employed by a licensed electrical contractor and have a high school diploma or GED. May also qualify if working as an electrician/apprentice (under a licensed journeyman) for a manufacturing facility, maintenance organization, commercial facility, institutional facility, or utility organization.
