## **Admission Requirements**

To be eligible for the trucking program students must submit the following items in person to the Admissions Counselor once applications open (see class schedule). Seats are filled on a first come, first serve basis.

- 1. CDL Class "B" learner's permit.
  - Students will need to take their Permit test at the DMV office
  - The Florida CDL study handbook can be printed from the Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles website: <a href="https://www.flhsmv.gov/resources/handbooks-manuals/">https://www.flhsmv.gov/resources/handbooks-manuals/</a>
  - Study sections: 2 Driving Safely, 3 Transporting Cargo Safely, 5 Air Brakes
- **2.** Current Department of Transportation (DOT) Physical: You can use the following link to search for an approved medical provider:

- 3. Last 2-years of your US Motor Vehicle Record (pull NO Earlier than 45 days before the class start date)
  - Students will need to obtain their 3-year driving record.
  - You will need an appointment at the DMV to obtain your record, so plan accordingly

- 4. Once approved, all program fees will be due up front to reserve a seat in the class.

## <mark>Please Note</mark>:

This program is not eligible for the Pell grant or Federal Student loans, however, if you apply for FAFSA at <a href="https://www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a> and use our school code, 013917, you can meet with our financial aid staff to explore grant opportunities that would pay a portion of the fees.

There are also 2 agencies that will fund this program if you are eligible for their services, Career Source Pinellas (https://careersourcepinellas.com/) and St. Pete Works (https://stpeteworks.org/).

Any financial aid that a student plans to use must be arranged prior to coming into apply
