Class hours: Monday through Thursday 7am -2:30pm

Average length of a class: 320 hours

Total cost to enroll in the program: \$3281.40

Admission Requirements

1. *Students must be at least 21 years of age and have at least 3 years of driving experience*
2. **Apply to the college online at: <https://apply.myptc.edu/>**
3. ***You will be required to upload copies of the following to your online application:***
 - ✓ **Current Department of Transportation (DOT) Medical Card:** You can use the following link to search for an approved medical provider: <https://nationalregistry.fmcsa.dot.gov/search-medical-examiners>
 - ✓ **CDL Class “A” learner’s permit**
 - The Florida CDL handbook can be printed from the Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles website: <https://www.flhsmv.gov/pdf/handbooks/englishcdlhandbook.pdf>
 - Study chapters: 2 Driving Safely, 3 Transporting Cargo Safely, 5 Air Brakes, 6 Combination Vehicles.
 - Students will need to take their Permit test at the DMV office
 - Pinellas County DMV walk-ins accepted until 3pm
 - Let the DMV clerk know that you want to take the General Knowledge, Transporting Cargo, Air Brakes and Combination Vehicles tests
 - ✓ **The last 3-years of your Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) *pulled within 45 days of the class start date***
 - You can purchase your MVR at the DMV or on the MyDMVportal (<https://mydmvportal--flhsmv.force.com/>)
4. **Pay Program fees**
 - *Once approved, all program fees will be due up front to register for a seat in the class.*

Please Note:

This program is not eligible for the Pell grant or Federal Student loans, however, if you apply for FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov and use our school code, 013917, you can meet with our financial aid staff to explore grant opportunities that would pay a portion of the fees.

There are 2 local Agencies that will fund students, Career Source Pinellas and St. Pete Works (www.stpeteworks.org). Students would need to check with those agencies for eligibility.

Any financial aid that a student plans to use must be arranged prior to coming into apply.

*****To qualify for the posted in state tuition, students must be able to prove that they have lived in Florida for at least a year.***
