# **Student Accident Insurance**

## is available for Pinellas Technical College (PTC) & K12 students enrolled in Pinellas County Schools

- Coverage is required for students participating in certain programs and extra-curricular activities
- This supplemental insurance coordinates with any other health insurance you may have
- This plan does not contain a deductible provision
- Coverage may be purchased any time during the 2024-2025 school year
- Coverage ends July 31, 2025

#### Mandatory PTC Student Accident Insurance (Specific Programs & Activities)

The Pinellas County School Board, like most school boards in the State of Florida, requires students participating in certain school activities to purchase student accident insurance. This requirement will help ensure that every student who participates in certain activities is covered. This coverage is required even if the student is covered by another medical plan or program. There are no exceptions to this requirement as it is school board policy (School Board Policy 8760; learn more at: https://www.pcsb.org/studentaccidentinsurance)
