Computer-Aided Drawing and Modeling

Location: St. Petersburg
Length: 1200 hrs (approx 12 mos)
Tuition: \$3,504
Other: \$1,416 (bks, equip & fees; estimate)

This program offers rigorous content and relevant technical knowledge and skills needed to prepare for careers in the Architecture and Construction career cluster. Content includes the use of software to convert the engineering or architectural designs into technical drawings. Students can specialize in architectural, civil, or mechanical drafting and use technical drawings to design everything from microchips to skyscrapers.



Electricity

Prepare for employment as an electrician. Content includes basic safety and code, circuits, diagramming, all phases of residential wiring circuits and installation, pipe bending, transformers, motor controls, and data and fiber cabling.
