Class hours are 7 am to 2 pm Monday through Thursday

Average length of a class is 9 weeks or 320 hours

Total cost of the program is **\$3003.00**

***Must be at least 21 years of age***

### **Admission Requirements**

1. Satisfactory 3-year Motor Vehicle Record (**no older than 45 days prior to the class start date**)
2. Current Department of Transportation (DOT) Physical
3. Current Class A Permit
4. Fees to pay for the course

**To be eligible for the trucking program students must submit the following to the Admissions Counselor no earlier than 40 days prior to the start of a class. Seats are filled on a first come, first serve basis.**

1. 3-year Motor Vehicle Record (**No older than 45 days prior to the class start date**)
  - Students will need to obtain their 3-year driving record. You can order online at [dmvflorida.org/driving-records](http://dmvflorida.org/driving-records) OR visit your local DMV office.
2. Current Department of Transportation (DOT) Physical
  - Concentra Urgent Care: 3745 33<sup>rd</sup> St. N. St. Petersburg, 727-231-0154
  - Or search for **FMCSA certified facilities at national registry** <https://www.fmcsa.dot.gov/>
3. CDL Class “A” learners permit.
  - Students will need to take their Permit test at the DMV office
  - The Florida CDL study handbook can be printed from the Florida Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles website: <https://www3.flhsmv.gov/handbooks/englishcdlhandbook.pdf>.  
**Study sections: 2 Driving Safely, 3 Transporting Cargo Safely, 5 Air Brakes, 6 Combination Vehicles.**
4. Once approved, all program fees will be due up front to hold a seat in the class.
