A "Sharps Injury" exists if: (a) an object, such as a needle, scalpel, broken glass, etc., penetrates the skin or mucous membrane of a school district employee, and (b) this object contacted the blood of another person, or contacted other potentially infectious material (OPIM) prior to penetrating the skin or mucous membrane of a school district employee.					
In addition to documenting the below listed information, the Sharps Injury Log shall: • Maintain sharps injuries separately from other injuries and illnesses. • Include all sharps injuries that occur during a calendar year. • Be retained for 5 years beyond the completion of that calendar year. • Preserve the confidentiality of affected employees.
