## HOW DO I EARN IT?

Employees must complete course [#33477 ESE: Youth Mental Health First Aid - 6 Hour](#), download and submit an electric copy of a valid certificate in Youth Mental Health First Aid USA issued by the National Council for Mental Wellbeing, and complete an assigned project.

## HOW DO I MAINTAIN IT?

Employees must earn three credit hours of professional learning offered by the Prevention Office each school year.
