WHAT IS IT?

The Mental Health Micro-Credential recognizes and celebrates employees who actively engage in mental health related professional learning offered by the Prevention Office.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All employees of Pinellas County Schools.

HOW DO I EARN IT?

Employees must complete course #33477 ESE: Youth Mental Health First Aid - 6 Hour, download and submit an electric copy of a valid certificate in Youth Mental Health First Aid USA issued by the National Council for Mental Wellbeing, and complete an assigned project.

HOW DO I MAINTAIN IT?

Employees must earn three credit hours of professional learning offered by the Prevention Office each school year.
