Qualifying Events: Changing Your Insurance Benefits Mid-Year

Just a reminder that under IRS regulations, you cannot change your benefits during the year unless you have a qualified life event, and it is consistent with the requested benefit change. To make a change, you must submit an Enrollment & Change form to Risk Management within 31 days of the life event. Supporting documentation is required. Changes are effective the first of the month following the life event AND receipt of the paperwork in Risk Management.



What are Examples of Qualifying Life Events?

- Marriage or Divorce
- Birth or adoption of a child (coverage effective immediately)
- Death of a family member
- You or your spouse start or end an unpaid leave of absence
- You or your spouse gain or lose coverage through an employer or State-sponsored plan (Medicare, Medicaid) Note: signing up for a private individual plan, such as a health, life insurance or disability plan, will not qualify as a life event to drop coverage
- You or your dependent lose employer group coverage for any reason, or your COBRA coverage expires

Diabetes Care Program


