- 3. What social issue(s) may students address through community service work at your organization? We primarily focus on protection of wildlife, natural resources, and land through science based education and outreach. We also partner with other organizations. Through our partnership with Keep Pinellas Beautiful we have encountered a connection between social struggles and environmental needs. One of the sites we conduct beach clean-ups at has become a refuge for homeless people. This would be an excellent opportunity for a student who may be focusing on both the issues. We have also done educational outreach to a foster community and Girl Scout troops.

- 5. What are some typical activities that students might perform if they complete community service hours with your organization? We conduct beach clean-ups two or three times a year. We do educational outreach using lesson plans we develop. We also research information and write blog articles that encourage positive environmental stewardship and coexistence with wildlife. We develop lesson plans and create activities to engage students in learning about wildlife, environmental issues, and science. We encourage students to use their personal talents and to be creative. We currently have one young volunteer creating an adult coloring book for our organization. Another helped with digging holes to relocate gopher tortoises.
- 6. When can students volunteer at your organization? Students can volunteer at any of our scheduled events. Currently we have the St. Petersburg Science Festival Scheduled for October 20-21, Tampa Bay Vegfest scheduled for November 4, and a beach clean-up at Gandy beach scheduled for October 14th. Students can also volunteer their talents at other times. If students want to work on a unique idea of their own we can work with them or if they want to schedule a fundraiser we can enhance it with education and outreach. If students want to work on writing a research article for a blog or our guest corner in our newsletter we can work with the student and help show them how to enhance their work by referencing scientific studies.
