

LAKE ST. GEORGE ELEMENTARY SIP 2015-16 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Lake St. George Elementary School has 563 students grades Prek to 5th. There are two administrators, 51 teachers, and 38 staff members. The mission of Lake St. George is to provide a quality education that promotes highest student achievement by being actively involved in continually improving the educational process.

To accomplish this mission, Lake St. George has 5 Goals:

Goal 1: To increase the percentage of students scoring Level 3 and above on 2016 Reading FSA from 74% to 75%, the percentage of students making learning gains from 69% to 75%, and the percentage of students in the lowest 25% making learning gains from 61% to 70%

Goal 2: To increase the percentage of students scoring a 3.5 or above on 2016 Writing FSA from 69% to 75%.

Goal 3: To increase the percentage of students scoring a Level 3 or above on 2016 FCAT Science from 59% to 70%.

Goal 4: To increase the percentage of students scoring Level 3 or above on 2016 Math FSA from 66% to 75%, the percentage of students making learning gains from 66% to 75%, and the percentage of student in the lowest 25% making learning gains from 64% to 70%

Goal 5: To increase the percentage of African American students scoring a Level 3 and above on the 2016 Reading FSA from 50% to 100%. To increase the percentage of African American students scoring Level 3 and above on the 2016 Math FSA from 29% to 100%

The core instructional strategies included in our action plans are: teachers will engage implementation of the Florida State Standards for literacy and math, utilize an additional 30 minutes of math to remediate and enrich students, use research-based strategies in core science instruction (Science Modules and Lab work). Text Dependent Questioning, Collaboration, Speaking and Listening, Content Enhancement), participate in

appropriate writing training, and implement a mentor program which will pair a staff member with identified African American students.

The professional development efforts include attending state, district and school based trainings on Florida State standards-and FAIR FS. Staff development will also be done through grade level and cross grade level PLCs.

The parent involvement efforts showed that about 60% of our parents are involved in events occurring at school, including parent conferences, parent education workshops, and Open Houses. We know that parent involvement is an indicator for success; therefore we are focusing on involving the parents of our lowest 25% in both reading and math for the upcoming school year.
