EARLY ADMISSION (EA)

DEADLINE: March 1st

- Juniors apply to attend in your Senior year
 - > 12 to 15 credits
 - ➤ Higher entrance GPA 3.8+
- Early Admission, a form of dual enrollment where eligible high school Junior students apply to attend USF fulltime in their Senior Year
 - Juniors seeking to attend EA at USF in their Senior year must begin the application process in the FALL of their Junior Year

Once admitted as an early admission degree seeking student, you will not have to reapply to USF to continue your course work in your degree. After high school graduation, you will be considered a First Time in College Student at USF, as no Freshman application will be needed.
