

INSTRUCTIONS TO SEARCH FOR AVAILABLE CLASSES

STEP 1: You do not have to log in. Use your Chrome browser to utilize this link: <https://web.spcollege.edu/classes> to search for classes.

STEP 2: Begin by selecting the Academic Term, I.E. Spring, Summer, or Fall.



STEP 3: Select a preferred modality by clicking on the tab. For example, click on face-to-face if you only want to take an in-person class.



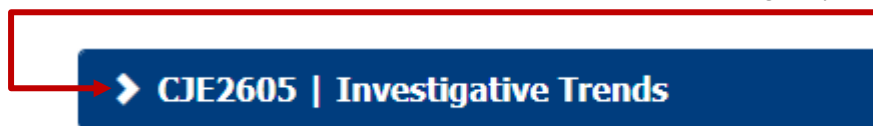
STEP 4: Refine your search by session, campus, days, and times, etc.
