Dress Code Policy:

Avoid the following styles:

- Any tight fitting skirts and miniskirts (pencil, maxi, bubble skirts, high/low etc.)
- Tops/shirts/blouses with over sized necklines that expose shoulders or bra straps
- No tank tops
- Tops with spaghetti straps even if hidden by a jacket that typically remains unzipped and falls off of the shoulder revealing the straps
- Low cut tops or V-neck shirts
- Tops that do not completely cover the midriff even with arms raised and when seated
- See through tops
- Leggings as pants, unless they are covered by shorts or skirts that fall no more than three inches above the knee
- Form fitting leotard/spandex type clothing
- Shorts/skirts/dresses that are shorter than three inches above the knee
- Pajamas and house shoes
- Jeans or pants that show ANY skin via holes..
- No hats, bandanas, etc.
- Pants worn below the waist line or sagging
- Exposed underwear/ undershorts

Important: Please Read!

Meadowlawn MS has a full time Nurse available to address medical needs of our scholars. It is imperative that Clinic Cards are accurately completed by a parent and returned to the school within the 1st week of school. This information provides a means for us to contact parents in the event of illness or accident, and, even more importantly, authorizes emergency medical treatment for a student, should it be necessary. Please look for the yellow clinic card to be brought home during the first days of school. Be sure to complete it and return it to the school.

Medications at School: For all medication taken at school by students, we must have both parent and physician permission. Documentation must be submitted to the Clinic.

Visitors/Parents: All visitors/parents must present drivers license to obtain a visitors pass. For the safety of our students and staff no one will be allowed to enter the campus without appropriate identification. Each grade level has an administrator, a counselor, and a clerk in the grade level office. If you have a question regarding your child and you are unsure who to ask for, please call the grade level clerk, and she will direct you to the appropriate administrator or counselor to assist you.
