MAJOR FUNCTION:

This is an instructional position responsible for job placement of exceptional students.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Developing a thorough knowledge of jobs in which students will be placed by physically performing all tasks, which will be required of students at job sites.
- Meeting with parents, teachers and students prior to job placement to obtain information regarding student's employability skills.
- Meeting with permanent employees at the job site prior to student placement to establish a conducive working environment.
- Maintaining on-going contact with permanent employees at the job site after student placement to confer regarding student performance.
- Providing on-site assistance to students as needed.
- Collecting and recording performance data for each student and providing feedback to students regarding job performance.
- Monitoring student attendance and punctuality.
- Implementing behavioral management procedures.
- Assigning grades for students
- Sending time sheets to schools for audit purposes.
- Meeting with employers, parents, teachers and students.
- Assisting in Individual Education Plan (IEP) planning for transition IEP meetings.
- Coordinating with post secondary agencies for transition.
- Coordinating activities for students pursuing a Special Diploma under Option 2 (full time employment).
- Continuing professional growth through meetings, attending workshops, visiting related facilities, reading related literature and exchanging ideas with other staff members.
- Performing other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's degree from a fully accredited college or university. Possession of, or eligibility for, a Florida teaching certificate for the level and subject area to be taught.
