AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Performs semi-skilled duties in the operation of various types of light automotive or simple construction equipment and associated mechanical attachments. Incumbent is responsible for routine vehicular maintenance and, when not driving, performs light to heavy physical labor. Work is performed under direct supervision; assignments are made daily and reviewed during progress or upon completion.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Operates dump truck, flatbed or similar vehicle hauling construction and maintenance equipment; operates trucks, back-hoe, front-end loader, or forklifts.
- Operates tractor pulling mechanical attachments such as harrow, rotovator, roller, pulvimixer, mower or trailer.
- Does routine maintenance on vehicles; makes emergency repairs if necessary; performs light to heavy physical labor when not driving.
- Applies knowledge of operation and maintenance of motor equipment and related attachments; of traffic and vehicular regulations governing use of motor equipment, and of hazards and safety precautions involved in operations.
- Performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Demonstrated ability to follow oral and written instructions in the English language. One (1) year of experience operating light to heavy automotive equipment in an urban setting. Possession of a valid State of Florida Class A commercial driver's license (CDL) to include "air brake" qualifications, and any other license as may be required by law.
