APPLIANCE / REFRIGERATION TECHNICIAN

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Performs semi-skilled work in the installation, repair, and preventive maintenance of food services, culinary arts, home economics, and other school facilities' equipment and appliances. Assists with large and small appliance repair. Work is performed under general direction with some independence. Work is reviewed during progress and upon completion for results obtained.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assists with the repair and maintenance of food services, culinary arts, home economics and warehouse equipment such as refrigerators, stoves, small kitchen appliances, dish washers, washing machines and dryers, freezers, pulpers, compressors, etc
- Assists with the diagnosis and repair of common equipment defects, applying knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions
- Performs preventive maintenance on equipment routinely to alleviate more serious future problems.
- Operates a truck in the field to handle emergency and routine service problems, as assigned
- Performs heavy lifting on a routine basis
- Performs related work as assigned

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, plus two (2) years experience in commercial and domestic major and small appliance and refrigeration repair, performing most of the above mentioned duties and responsibilities. The successful completion of up to two (2) years of verifiable formal training in the trade (vocational, military, or indentured apprentice school) may be substituted for a like amount of the experience requirement. Possession of a valid State of Florida Class E noncommercial driver's license and any other license as may be required by law.
