PLASTERER-JOURNEYMAN

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Performs skilled construction work in alteration and repair of buildings and structures doing a variety of plastering, stucco work and tile setting tasks. Incumbent uses specialized knowledge and skills in finishing stucco in accordance with standard trade practices. Work is performed under general direction with considerable independence and is reviewed by inspection in progress or upon completion for conformity with instructions and established standards.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Reads blueprints, sketches and specifications; plans work; estimates costs, materials and time.
- Installs metal lath, rock lath and corner bends; manipulates trowels; floats and screens on plaster and stucco to secure a specified finish; tapes and finishes drywall joints.
- Rigs and erects scaffolding; hauls and erects ladders; lifts heavy objects and works at heights on a routine basis.
- Applies knowledge of various types of cement and plaster, including stress and strain ratio of mix and bonds; of practice materials and tools used in plaster trade.
- Performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, plus four (4) years progressively responsible work experience as a plasterer. The successful completion of up to two (2) years of verifiable formal training in the trade (vocational, military, or indentured apprentice school) may be substituted for a like amount of the experience requirement. Possession of a valid State of Florida Class E noncommercial driver's license, and any other license as may be required by law.
