POOL TECHNICIAN

MAJOR FUNCTION:

Performs work in maintenance and repair of swimming pools, pool water and filter systems. Assignments are received orally or through blueprints or sketches and are performed independently and reviewed upon completion for conformity with instructions and established standards.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Installs pool systems; makes general repairs to existing installations of swimming pool systems and similar installations.
- Replaces, cleans, makes repairs to filters; caulks pools; wipes and tests joints and connections; removes stoppage from lines; cuts seams and threads pipes; repairs pool motors, switches, etc.
- Draws rough layouts and sketches of plumbing to be installed; prepares estimates of materials, time and labor necessary for job completion.
- Applies skill in the use of tools of the plumbing trade.
- Applies knowledge of plumbing practices related to layout and installation of pipe systems and fixtures, of materials and tools and their application to swimming pool systems.
- Works from blueprints, designs, and diagrams of plumbing systems.
- Keeps records and prepares simple reports.
- Performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Four (4) years progressively responsible experience in installation; repair and maintenance of a wide variety of plumbing and pipe systems in connection with swimming pool systems; some experience in water chemistry or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
