- Demonstrates teaching techniques in classrooms and other settings.
- Assists in monitoring budgets.
- Promotes the use of integrated management systems and their alignment to district goals.
- Coordinates Student Achievement Institutes.
- Supports student achievement research and development.
- Collects and reports student achievement data.
- Demonstrates computer applications, including Excel.
- Assists schools in resolving technology problems related to SAM.
- Makes recommendations for district data collection processes.
- Performs other related duties as required.
