Do you have a car seat for your child, but are not sure how to install it properly in your vehicle?

When calling the MCO (at the phone number above), you will be asked for your Medicaid number, trip purpose and details like address and time of appointment. The MCO will send this information to one of their transportation brokers, who will schedule the trip with a local transportation provider.

If there is a problem with the trip, call the MCO's transportation number first, as they will enforce their contract with the transportation broker who will talk to the transportation provider. If this is not effective, file a complaint with AHCA via their website or phone number.
