

OAK GROVE - MODIFIED STUDENT DRESS CODE

This modified student dress code will be enforced, along with school board policy, in regards to student dress. Board approved May 8, 2012.

Administration Has The FINAL Say Regarding Dress Code

❖ Dress Shirts (short and long sleeve) and Polos:

Shirts must be **solid** in color, have a collar, and be gold/yellow, white, navy, gray or black.

They must fit neatly and not be oversized (cannot extend below the wrists when arms are held at side) or undersized (must extend below the waistline). Polos are defined as a collared shirt. Solid in color means, no graphics, pictures, numerals, slogans, etc. No see through material or excessively tight shirts will be allowed. A small logo (no bigger than 2 inches) on polos is acceptable.

❖ T-Shirts – Oak Grove T-Shirts ONLY

School approved Oak Grove T-shirts are the only T-Shirts that may be worn. These T-shirts will follow Oak Grove's color scheme. They must be worn as intended and not tied up, torn, or altered in any way.

❖ Pants/shorts /skirts/capris

They may be khaki or black, neat in appearance (un-torn), worn at the waist (as per state statute) with a belt, and must be knee length (Bermuda shorts/walking shorts). Capris would also be appropriate as they fall below the knee. **No jean shorts or capris are allowed.** Athletic, nylon, or knit type shorts/pants are not permitted, with the exception of gym class.

❖ Dresses

Dresses may be worn that are solid in color (gold/yellow, white, gray, black, and khaki) and knee length or longer.

❖ Jeans (pants only) Blue or Black

Blue jeans are allowed as long as they are neat in appearance and they are plain solid blue or black, full length, free of any wording, embroidery, designs, as well as un-torn/un-ripped/no holes/frays. No midriff or rear skin should be showing when the student is standing or sitting.

NO SPANDEX, JEGGINGS, LEGGINGS, SWEAT PANTS, PAJAMAS, YOGA PANTS, ARE ALLOWED. HEADBANDS, BANDANAS, HATS, CHAINS are also not allowed.

❖ Footwear:

Shoes with a heel strap or closed back. (No flip flops, sliders, house shoes, sandals with no back)

❖ Outerwear:

Plain, solid color sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets will be allowed. No logos or writing can be on the outerwear. OGMS hoodies/sweatshirts are allowed. (gold/yellow, white, navy, gray or black) Hoods are not to be worn on the head once a student is on campus. Students must wear dress code appropriate garments under their outerwear.

❖ Belts:

Belts are required when wearing shorts, pants and jeans. Current school board policy must be followed for appropriate images, etc.

❖ Exceptions:

Students may wear uniform shirts on game days. Students involved in cheerleading, band, chorus, and athletics - may wear their group uniforms on approved designated game days. Attire must be in accordance with Oak Grove dress code policy. Cheerleaders will not wear their cheer skirts/shorts during the school day.

❖ Physical Education:

Athletic, nylon, or knit type shorts/pants are permitted in gym class. **Black shorts, knee length, and a white T-shirt for boys, gray t-shirt for girls, are required for physical education, as well as appropriate footwear. (sneakers)**

Undergarments must not be visible. Students who do not change for PE class are given a 0 for the day.

IN ADDITION, PHONES, ELECTRONIC DEVICES, AND EAR BUDS WILL BE CONFISCATED IF WORN OR SEEN, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CLASSROOM USE. THESE ITEMS MUST BE OFF AND IN YOUR BACKPACK – NOT IN YOUR POCKET OR ON YOUR PERSON. ITEMS SEEN WILL BE CONFISCATED AND A PARENT WILL HAVE TO PICK IT UP.
