

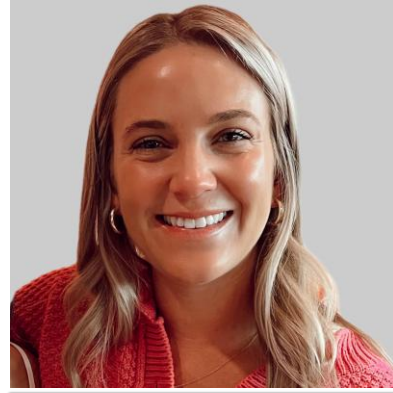
Welcome to SECOND Grade!

Welcome to Second Grade at Bay Vista Fundamental! My name is Ms. Glonek, and I am very excited to be your child's second grade teacher. You and your family are very important to me and I look forward to developing a partnership that will help make this year a success. The following is a list of supplies that will help your student to be successful this year:

- 1 three ring binder for agenda (any color) **1-inch**, with pockets on inside
- 1 three ring binder for writing (**red**) **½-inch**, with pockets on inside
- 1 pencil pouch or box
- 2 12-packs of number 2 pencils (Ticonderoga brand, **no** mechanical pencils or personal sharpeners)
- 2 packs of Crayola crayons – 24 pack
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 four-pack of glue sticks (small preferred)
- 1 small box of cap erasers
- 2 plastic folders (1 yellow, 1 any color/design)
- 3 composition books, wide ruled (one blue, green, and yellow composition book)
- 1 pair of headphones (over the head, not earbuds)
- Backpack (no wheels)
- 8 Black Expo Markers (skinny size)
