

ELEMENTARY CLINICIAN BIOGRAPHIES

Heather Cusmano- Chorus

Heather Cusmano is a distinguished music educator with 21 years of experience teaching chorus, 16 of them being at Northside Christian School in St. Petersburg. She holds a Master's degree in Music Education from the University of South Florida and a Bachelor of Music from Palm Beach Atlantic University. She has conducted choirs and musical theatre ensembles with precision and artistry. Her choral groups have consistently received Superior ratings at the Florida Vocal Association Performance Assessments. She is deeply committed to mentoring future music educators and takes pride in the success of her former students, several of whom have gone on to establish thriving careers in music education. Beyond her educational roles, Heather extends her musical leadership as the director of the adult choir at Indian Rocks Baptist Church in Largo, FL. In her spare time, Heather enjoys traveling to the mountains with her family.

Emmanuel Fergile- World Drumming

Emmanuel Fergile, obtained his Bachelor of Arts degree in Music Education and his Master of Arts degree in Choral Conducting, both from Florida Atlantic University. He is Orff Schulwerk Level III Certified. Currently, he is a music teacher, and directs a chorus, handbell choir, and world drumming ensembles at Highland Elementary in the School District of Palm Beach County. Additionally, he is a teacher ambassador, volunteer lead mentor at his school, and the Elementary Liaison for the School District of Palm Beach County Spotlight on Young Musicians. He was born in the Bahamas to Haitian parents, a former member of the Royal Bahamas Police Force, the Bahamas National Youth Choir, and the Bahamas National Dance Company. He was nominated on several occasions for the Teacher of the Year for Highland Elementary, for the prestigious Dwyer Award for Excellence in Education. He is currently pursuing another master's degree in Educational Leadership with the ExEq Program in Palm Beach County.

Rosemary Pilonero - Orff

Rosemary Pilonero is currently in her 30th year of teaching music and 10th year at The Villages Elementary of Lady Lake in Lake County, Florida. She previously taught music for 8 years in Sumter County, Florida and for 12 years in Ramsey, New Jersey. She has a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Massachusetts at Amherst and a Master's Degree from Montclair State University in New Jersey. Mrs. Pilonero has completed her Orff Certification as well as two Orff Master Classes. She is a past Treasurer of the Central Florida Orff Chapter (CFOC) and the 2024 CFOC/Orange County Public Schools Orff Levels Course Director. Rosemary has been a clinician for All-County Orff ensembles in Orange, Seminole, and Polk counties, and workshop clinician in Pinellas and Polk Counties, as well as several Orff chapters. In 2022, she conducted the Florida Elementary Music Educators Association (FEMEA) Central Regional Orff Ensemble. She served as a Regional Representative on the American Orff-Schulwerk Association (AOSA) National Board of Trustees and is currently serving as National Conference Chair of the 2024 AOSA Iowa Conference in Des Moines. An FEMEA Past-President, Rosemary continues to serve the Florida Music Education Association (FMEA) as All-State Elementary Orff Ensemble Co-Coordinator and Elementary Clinics Chair on the Conference Planning Committee. In 2021, she was awarded FMEA Elementary Music Educator of the Year. Rosemary lives in Wildwood with her husband, Mark, and their dogs, Bella and Dolce.

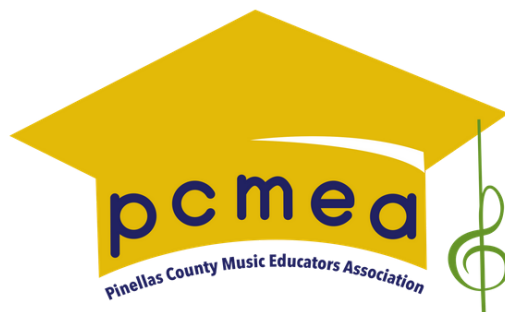
