Meet the Conductors

Peter BarenBregge - is a professional saxophonist/flutist/clarinetist now living in the Sarasota-Venice area of Florida. He is the former musical director of the USAF Airmen of Note in Washington, D.C. After his 20+ year career and retirement from the USAF, he accepted the position as the instrumental jazz editor for Alfred Music where he edited, produced, and recorded hundreds of jazz ensemble arrangements plus many jazz education resources such as play-alongs, duets, piano and vocal books, transcription books, and pedagogy books. In addition to performing nationally and internationally, he has released three highly-rated CD recordings with Summit Records and is a voting member of the Grammys. Mr BarenBregge earned a BS in music education at West Chester University. He is the former director of the Columbia Jazz Band, Columbia, MD, and is the recipient of the 2015 Howard County Arts Council's Howie Award for Outstanding Artist.

Michael Kernodle - a native of Danville, VA, is a Music Education and Performance graduate of Virginia State University. This is his 8th year with Pinellas County as Director of Bands for Lakewood High School, St. Petersburg, FL. In his 18 years as an educator, he has taught band, orchestra, and general music in Bertie County Schools (NC), Danville Public Schools (VA), Asbury School of Music (Raleigh, NC), as well as the Marcia P. Hoffman School of the Arts at Ruth Eckerd Hall (Clearwater, FL). Mr. Kernodle has also performed with the Danville Symphony Orchestra as Second French Hornist and the Principal Hornist of the Sun City Symphony Orchestra. Under Mr. Kernodle’s direction, the Lakewood Jazz Ensemble has earned superior ratings on the district and state level. LHS Jazz is also the grand champion of the 2016 Crescent Music Festival in New Orleans and has recently performed at the 2018 New York City Jazz Festival held at the historic Apollo Theater. Mr. Kernodle currently serves as the Pastor of Music and Arts at the Designer's Way Christian Church in Tampa. He resides in Gibsonton, FL with his wife, Chennetta, and two children, Caryn and Xavier.

Rosemary Collins - is the director or choral activities at Clearwater High School in Clearwater, Florida. She holds a Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Southern Mississippi, and a Master of Music degree from Southeastern Louisiana University. She has taught in Pinellas for the last 16 years, 15 of those at Safety Harbor Middle School. Mrs. Collins has been honored in Pinellas County as a Teacher of the Year finalist (2010) and as a recipient of the Secondary Music Educator of the Year (2009). Choirs under her direction consistently receive high ratings and are invited to perform frequently throughout the Tampa Bay area. She is active in FMEA, FVA, and ACDA and conducts All-County Choirs throughout the state of Florida. More than anything, Rosemary loves to sing. In addition to her activities as a music educator and leader, she enjoys performing music alongside her husband and pianist, Stan Collins.
