Dr. Park is the artistic director and administrator for theUCF Symphony and Chamber Orchestras and Director of String Music Education. Orchestras Dr. Park has led have received wide critical acclaim. Dr. Park comes to the University of Central Florida most recently from Appalachian State University, where he was the Director of Orchestral Studies at the Haves School of Music. He also led the String and Symphony Orchestras at the HSoM's Cannon Music Camp. Prior appointments include positions at the Idaho State-Civic Symphony, Idaho State University, Frost School of Music at the University of Miami, as well as the faculties of the Universities of Chicago, North Dakota and Indiana University- South Bend. Park also served as conductor of the Western Michigan University Chamber Orchestra and Opera Theater and music director of vouth orchestras in South Bend, IN; Grand Forks, ND; Orlando, FL and Miami, FL. Dr. Park keeps a very active schedule as a guest conductor, presenter and clinician. He has recently led or will lead orchestras in Utah, Tennessee, Georgia, North Carolina, North Dakota and throughout the state of Florida, including the Orlando Philharmonic Orchestra. He is active as an adjudicator and strives to be a resource to area teachers, having led over seventy clinics in the schools during a little more than two years at UCF. Dr. Park was honored by the North Dakota String Teacher's Association with their Distinguished Service Award in 2008. He was also awarded the Pocatello Arts Council Community Service Award and named "Businessperson of the Year-Overachiever Under 40" by the Idaho State Journal and the Pocatello/Blackfoot Chamber of Commerce. Dr. Park loves to spend his free time with his family and even gets talked into playing board games on occasion. He also enjoys foraging for wild food, cooking, gardening organically, cycling, doing home renovations and reading.
