Meet the All-County Conductor

Michael Kernodle - is a native of Danville, VA. A graduate of Virginia State University, he holds a degree in Music Education and Performance.

In his 21 years as an educator, he has taught band, orchestra, and general music in Bertie County Schools (NC); Danville Public Schools (VA); Asbury School of Music (Raleigh, NC); and the Marcia P. Hoffman School of the Arts at Ruth Eckerd Hall (Clearwater, FL).

Most recently he served as Director of Bands at Lakewood High School, St. Petersburg, FL. During his tenure, the school's Jazz ensembles earned superior ratings at both the district and state levels. Nationally the ensemble was designated the Grand Champions of the 2016 Crescent Music Festival in New Orleans, LA. In 2018 Mr. Kernodle was afforded the opportunity to conduct his students as they performed during the New York City Jazz Festival held at the historic Apollo Theater.

As an instrumentalist, Michael has performed with the Danville Symphony Orchestra as Second French Hornist and the Principal Hornist of the Sun City Symphony Orchestra. He also frequently performs and records with various jazz, blues, and gospel musicians on trumpet and keyboard as well.

Mr. Kernodle currently serves as the Pastor of Music and Arts at Designer's Way Christian Church in Tampa, FL. In addition he is the founder and CEO of the Jireh Music Group, LLC. He resides in Gibsonton, FL with his wife, Chennetta, and two children, Caryn and Xavier.
