Just want to remind everyone about our testing schedule on page 3. It is important that students attend that day and appointments are not scheduled that day. If you have any questions regarding any of the assessments that your student is scheduled to take, please feel free to reach out to me.

Also we are now in our last quarter and I need all students to finish strong. If your student didn't get quite the grade that they were hoping for in quarter 3, now is the time to make it happen. Parents you can assist your student by helping them stay on track by doing the following every week:

1. Have your student check Focus - Do this with them so you can also see their grades, what assignments

are coming up and if any assignments have not been turned in.

2. If your student says that they turned an assignment in and you are not sure you can check by either seeing that they uploaded the assignment in Focus or on Canvas. If you are checking Canvas your student will need to log into Canvas and show you where it is uploaded.

3. Have your student do homework the night they receive the work (unless it is a project that requires more time). If students complete HW the night they receive it then they are always step ahead. I put this tip in because some students wait since we have an A/B day schedule and then this ends up causing stress. If they do their homework the night, they receive it then they have that extra time should something come up or they need to ask clarifying questions to their teacher.

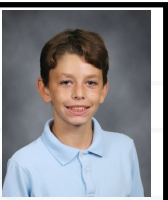

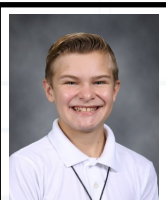
