



## **Fundamental School Within A School**

### **Overview of the Intervention and Appeal Committee (IAC)**

Each fundamental school has a school-based Intervention and Appeal Committee. The purpose of the committee is to review student cases, recommend probation, Recommend dismissal, suggest intervention that will increase student success, ensure compliance with approved procedures, and hear appeals. This committee is not authorized to reinvestigate situations but must accept the validity of administrative decisions regarding incidents. The Intervention and Appeal Committee members will serve a renewable one-year term.

The committee will meet on a regular, predetermined basis and when requested by the principal/designee. The principal, assistant principal, or guidance counselor may be available to answer questions when the committee meets. Only the committee members will have decision-making power. Decisions will be based on majority vote. The proceedings will be held in strict confidence.
