- Dunedin High School offers 19 AP classes including the AP Capstone courses, which lead to an AP Capstone Diploma recognized by thousands of universities, including all the Florida public universities.
- Nearly 70% of the seniors at Dunedin High School graduate with honors.
- Dunedin High School has many National Honor Societies including: National Honor Society, Spanish National Honor Society, Tri-M-Music National Honor Society, Math Honor Society, National Technical Society.
- Dunedin High School has a graduation rate of more than 97% well above the State and National graduation rate.
- Nearly 80% of the students at Dunedin High School graduate with at least one Advanced Placement or Dual Enrollment course, industry certification or state professional license.

- The Falcon Baseball Team made it to the regional finals or the state championship series 4 the last 5 years while having the highest GPA of any Baseball team in Pinellas County.
- The Lady Falcon Softball team won District Championships for the past 4 years.
- The distinguished NJROTC unit at DHS is ranked in the top 20 worldwide and the Orienteering Team has placed #2 in the Florida State Championships, and placed #1 in the Armed x Area 7 State Championship. They have also received the Unit Achievement Award for the past 7 years.
