2.CSS Profile (required by some colleges) www.student.collegeboard.org/css-financial-aid-profile

3. Institutional application (usually a part of the admissions packet)

You can find out which colleges require the CSS and Institutional application on individual university websites.

### NAVIANCE!!

Naviance has been a beast so far, for all of us! I have thrown myself into learning more about Naviance as quickly as possible!

#### Here's what I know:

- 1. It must be linked to your Common App.
- 2. You must list schools on your Common App. If you choose to list schools only in Naviance, it won't work...so anything you add to Naviance, must be added to Common App as well!
- 3. You must complete the *FERPA waiver*. This is done on Common App, under Colleges. Once you click on 1 college, you click the FERPA tab to waive or not. This hasn't been automatically rolling over to Naviance, so don't stress if it doesn't show up automatically.
- 4. You can *request a transcript* while adding colleges, or simply click the 'College' tab in Naviance to choose 'Manage Transcripts'.
- 5. For teacher LORs, simply click on the 'College' tab and select 'Letters of Recommendation'. You do not need to request a letter of recommendation from your counselor specifically...we automatically send one through Naviance as required. If you would like to send a "bragsheet" to your counselor to add some flair, etc., please feel free to do so! Most of you complete an activity like this in TOK. \*\*Highly recommended to choose 'select the appropriate college' for these LORs to be sent appropriately. When choosing 'general request', the LORs are picked up by colleges in random order. This is important especially if colleges have a maximum number they allow.

Pay special attention to the PowerPoint referred to on ManageBac, on 9/28, called "Naviance Student". Lots of helpful information is included.
