

The Sunshine State Young Readers Award Program is a statewide motivational reading program where students are the book judges, and grown-ups are not allowed a vote. Students who read at least 3 of the nominated Sunshine State books are eligible to vote for their favorite in the spring.

The Boys Read Book Battle Club will be competing in the "Boys Read" district-wide semifinals in January. The semi-finals are virtual, and the two school teams that are the finalists will compete "live" at the PCSB's Administration building. This group of fourth and fifth grade boys have been meeting after-school, digging deep into the books chosen for the Boys Read Club and having a great time in the process.
