

Dear Families,

We are excited to begin our next **Unit of Inquiry: How We Express Ourselves** in Spanish class! This unit focuses on personal, social, and cultural modes and practices of communication, helping students explore how people express ideas, feelings, and traditions in different ways.

Our central topic will be Family Traditions (Las tradiciones familiares).

Students will have the opportunity to:

- Share and talk about their own family traditions (las tradiciones familiares).
- Learn how families in Spanish-speaking countries celebrate important moments (celebraciones especiales).
- Practice new **Spanish vocabulary** such as: la familia (family)





- la tradición (tradition)
- la celebración (celebration)
- la comida (food)
- la música (music)

- o los bailes (dances)
- los valores (values)
- las costumbres (customs)
- la cultura (culture)
- la fiesta (party/celebration)

Students will use this vocabulary as they learn to describe how their families celebrate special events, and how traditions are passed down through generations. They will also explore how families in different Spanish-speaking countries express themselves through arte (art), música (music), and comida tradicional (traditional food). Through this inquiry, students will develop a deeper understanding of how traditions connect us and how we can appreciate the diversity of our community.
