

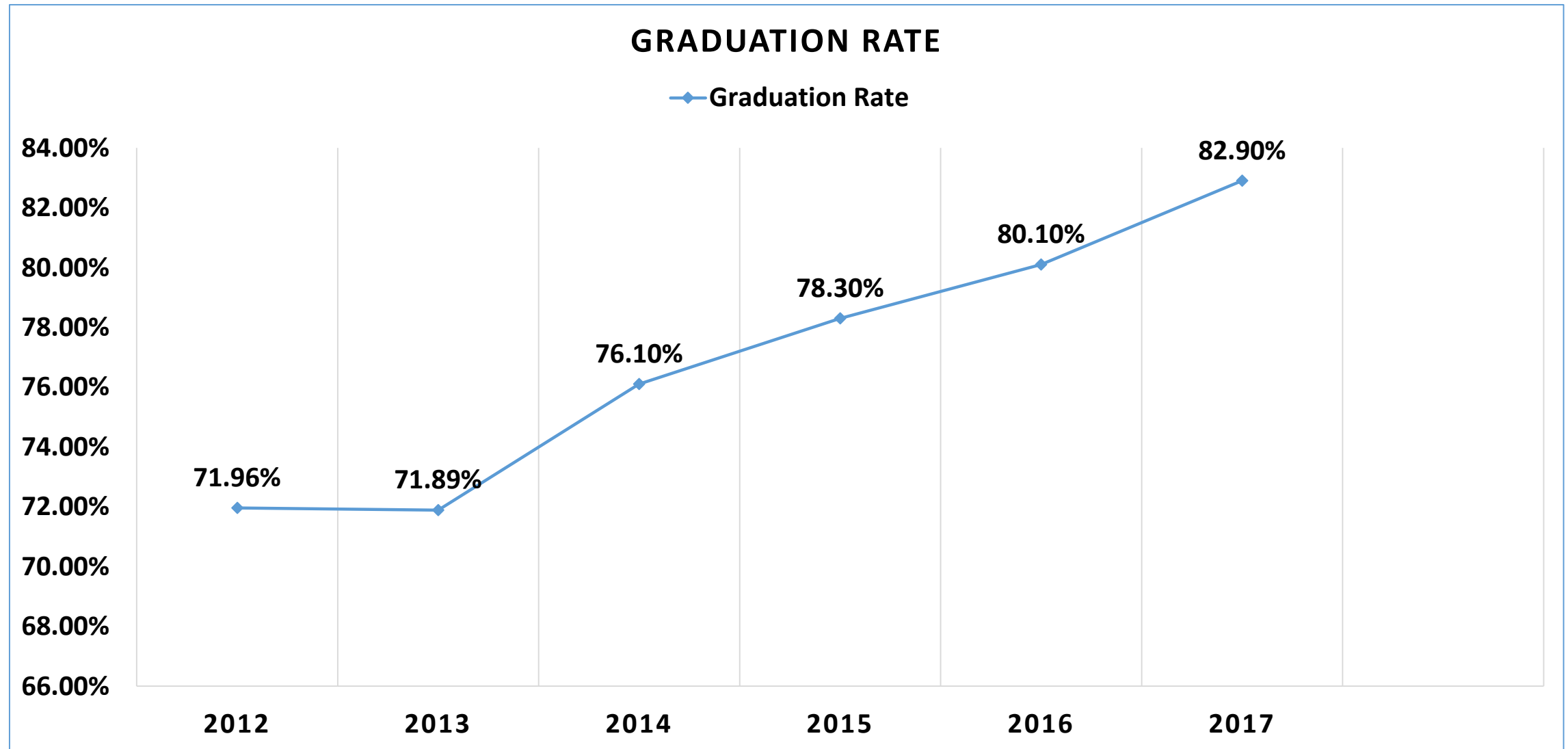

# Pinellas County Schools TIP Program

## SAT taken by identified seventh-graders

- Talent Identification Program aimed at high performing **seventh grade students** at each of our Pinellas County Middle School sites.
- Pinellas County Schools seventh grade students, who have registered, will take the SAT test at one of five Pinellas County Middle School test locations
- By participating in our TIP program students had the opportunity to test with their peers in an environment more familiar to them rather than at a high school with older students.
- The test is this Saturday, March 10 at John Hopkins, Safety Harbor, Seminole, East Lake and Oak Grove middle schools.

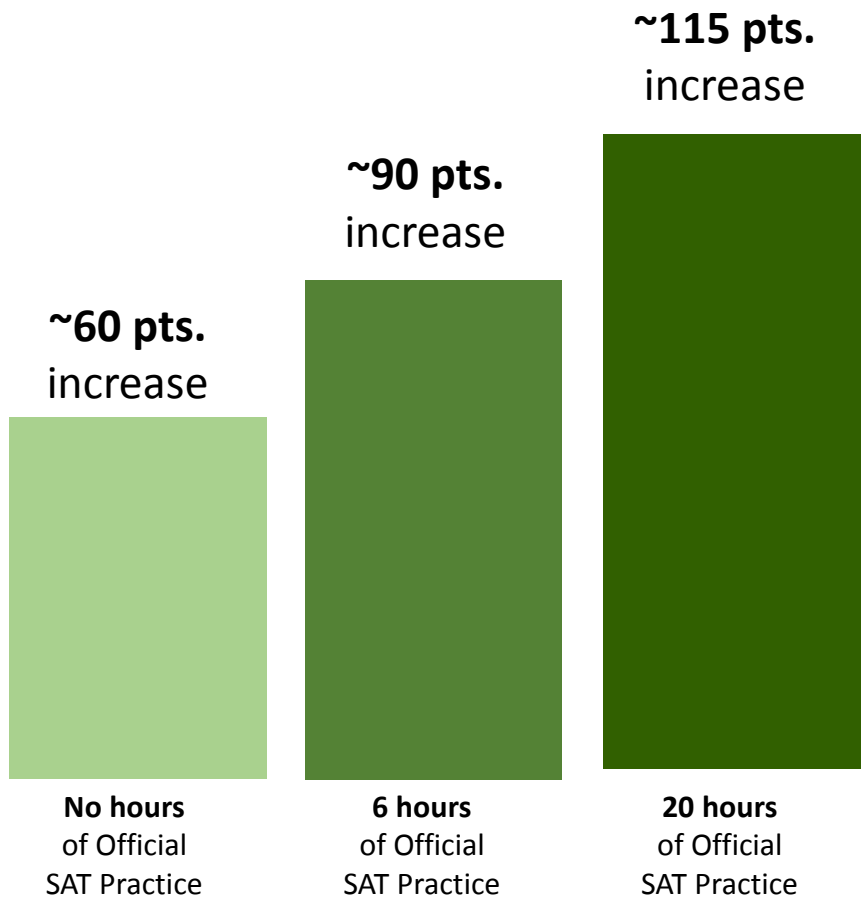

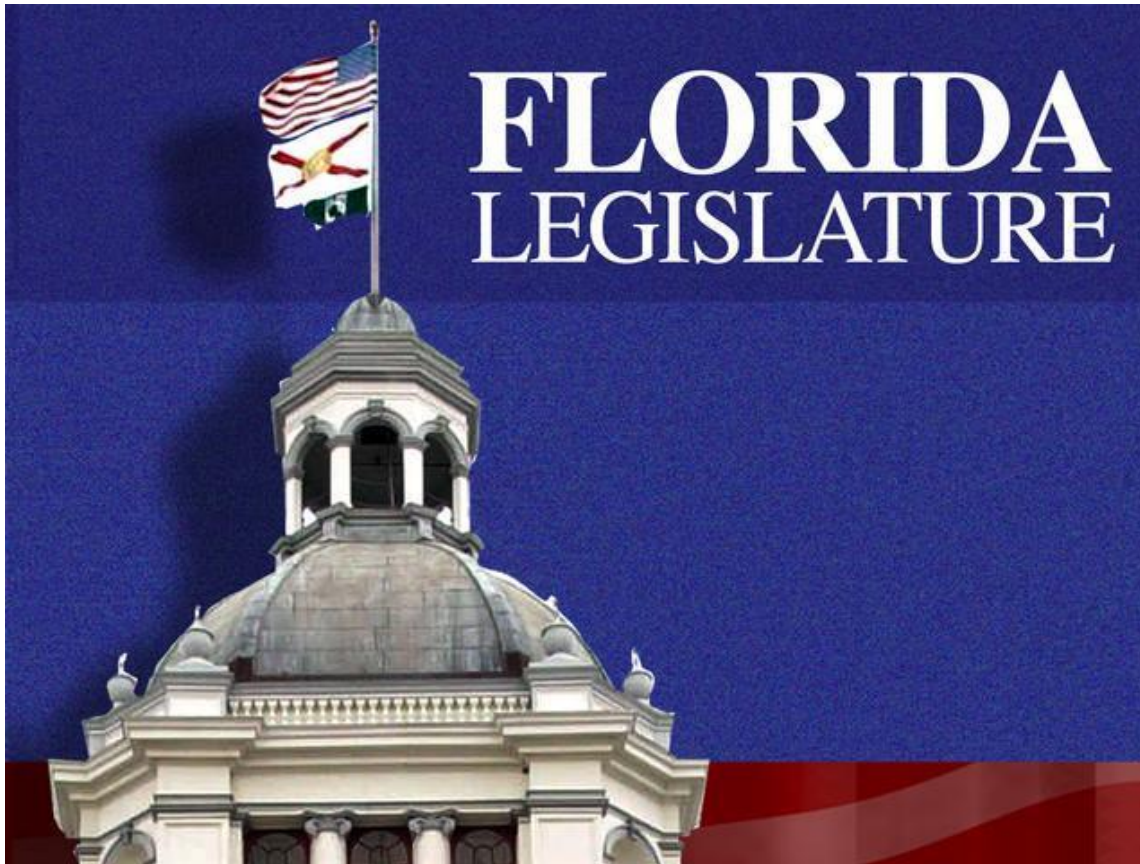

## Academic Achievements

- 2015-16 FSA data shows a 9% increase in the number of students proficient in ELA
- 2015-16 FSA data shows an 11% increase in the number of students proficient in Mathematics
- 2015-16 FSA data shows strong learning gains across grades 3-5 in both ELA and mathematics
- FSA data shows ELA scores and mathematics for students in grades 3-5 ahead of the district and the state averages
- SAT - 10 Grade 1 mathematics and reading scores higher than district
- SAT - 10 Grade 2 mathematics and reading scores higher than district
- Significant gains in SAT - 10 Grade 1 and Grade 2 reading and math scores 2016
- Significant gains in the number of students proficient in mathematics and ELA from 2015 to 2016 as measured by the Florida State Assessment
- Participated in Florida State University's Mathematics Formative Assessment System math pilot, K-1
- High level, web-based math and reading participation





## Points of Pride

- 72% of students performing proficient on the English Language Arts Florida State Assessment. (An increase of 12 %age points from 2016-17)
- 79% of students performing proficient on the Mathematics Florida State Assessment. (An increase of 7 %age points from 2016-17)
- 79% of students performing proficient on the Science Statewide Assessment. (An increase of 21 %age points from 2016-17)
- Significant gains made across all grades and content areas.
- A Top 10 Elementary School in Pinellas County based on State Assessments
- Awarded Media Incubator Grant from Pinellas Education Foundation
- Second place in the District level Battle of Books
- Teacher mini-grants
- Beautification projects
