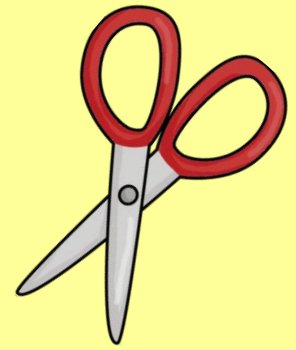
- **Mini lesson** - models writing; various teaching points, i.e. spacing, letter sounds, choosing topics, composing skills, conventions, etc.

- **Sharing Time** - Several children share their writing with the entire group and receive compliments and/or questions.





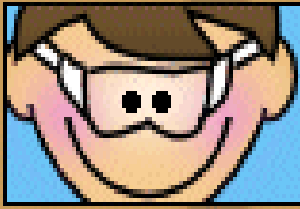


# Math

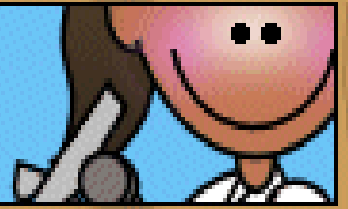


- **McGraw Hill** - hands on lessons about counting, operations and algebraic thinking, place value, classifying objects, and geometry

- **Problem Solving** - using manipulatives to solve word problems

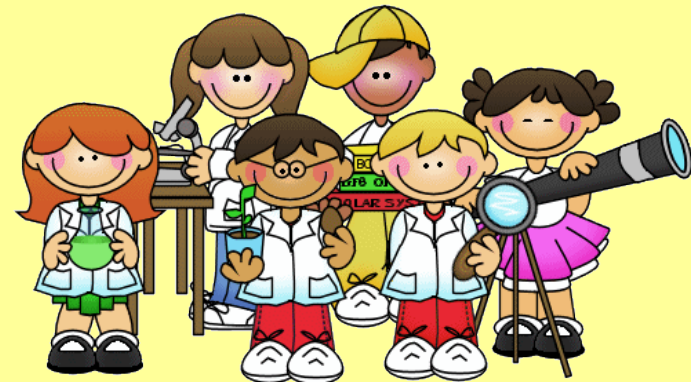
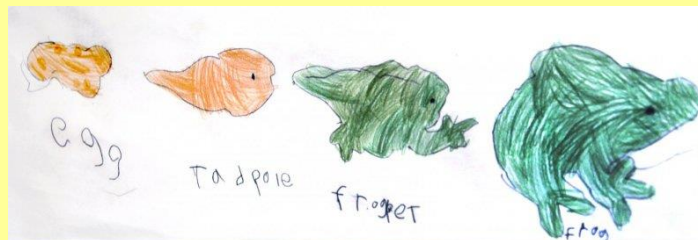
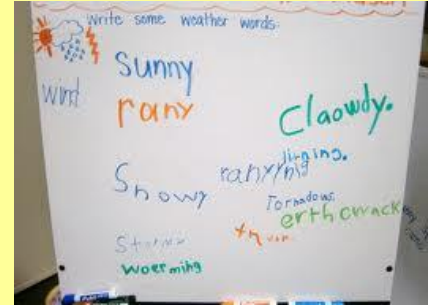

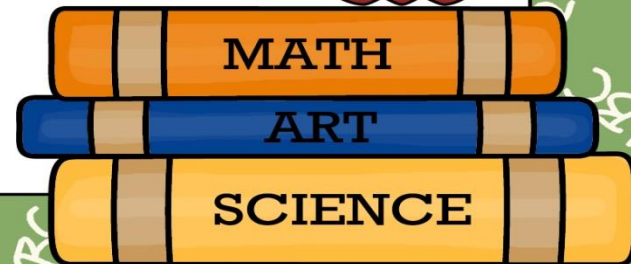






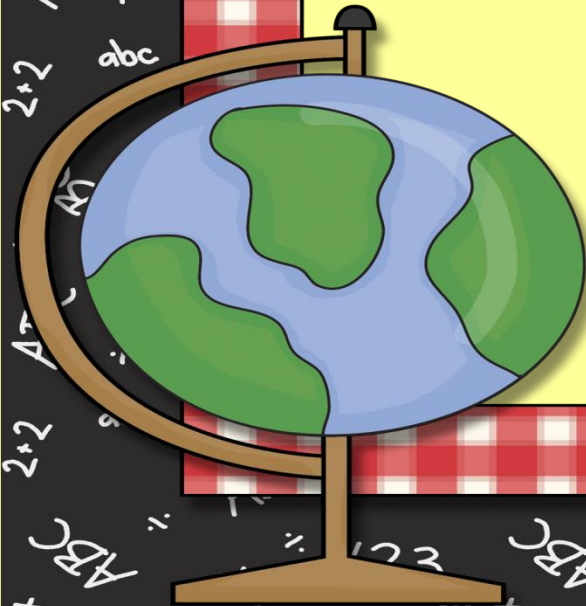
# Homework Policy
