Welcome and check in

Approval of November 2023 board meeting minutes to be approved at January meeting because of a revision.

Principal report- Teresa Price

Requesting communication help for everyone to be on the same page for Friday calls. PTA to set up a check-in time every Thursday morning to discuss the following week's events.

Wishlist discussion for PTA funds, examples included-

picnic tables for the breezeway

Classroom books/level readers

flexible seating as a rentable item for PBIS store

accelerated reader program (uses points and rewards, parents can look at progress via app)

PBIS store (money for kids to purchase experiences like a morning donut treat)

stem/science cart (portable cart that could be loaded and wheeled to classrooms from the science room)

classroom IPAD cart for 20 (specifically for K but can be used for other classes, K does not have computers and current IPADS are outdated)

There are additional items listed that were not discussed during the meeting.

PTA to pick the top 3 items to purchase with estimated spending of approx \$12000 (\$2500 toward the mosaic project). Will reassess for additional purchasing toward the end of the year with funds not used. Would like to get feedback from the staff, parents and students as to what items to purchase.

Teacher representative report- Michelle Morris

Drama microphones- the county purchased some and we received a donation last year from Disney. We need to see what else needs to be purchased using these funds.

The January PTA meeting speaker needs funding. \$300. The topic is math curriculum. Motion to approve by Kellie and second from Kelly.

Treasurer report- Shannon Bochichio

Beginning Check Balance = \$52,582.79

- Ending Checking Balance = \$52,819.03
- Tiger Trot raised a total of \$26,742.22 This exceeds our projected income by nearly \$15,750
- Notable income for November includes: an additional \$6230 from Tiger Trot, Zervos & Calta donated \$500 for Santa Breakfast
- Notable expenses for November includes: We spent about \$385 on the Fire Dept/Police Dept appreciation breakfast and \$233 on staff recognition for Staff Member of the Year.

Budget committee formed to further discuss rebudgeting and adding/deleting line items. Committee members include Shannon, Kelly, Kellie, Katie, and Michelle. Meeting to take place next week.

Budget needs to be voted on at the January PTA meeting.
