- Our campus opens for students at 8:15 a.m. each day.
 Please don't drop off or leave kids unattended prior to this time.
- Please use our car circle for pick-up and drop off unless your student walks to school. This is the safest and most efficient way for students to enter and exit the campus.
- Please do not drop students off in the street. This is very unsafe.
- School starts promptly at 8:45. Please ensure that your child arrives in a timely manner to arrive to class on time
- Students arriving after 8:45, must be signed in at the front office with an adult.
- For the safety of all, please use the identified crosswalks when coming on campus.
- Visitors must enter through the front office when visiting our campus. Please have identification on you at all times.
