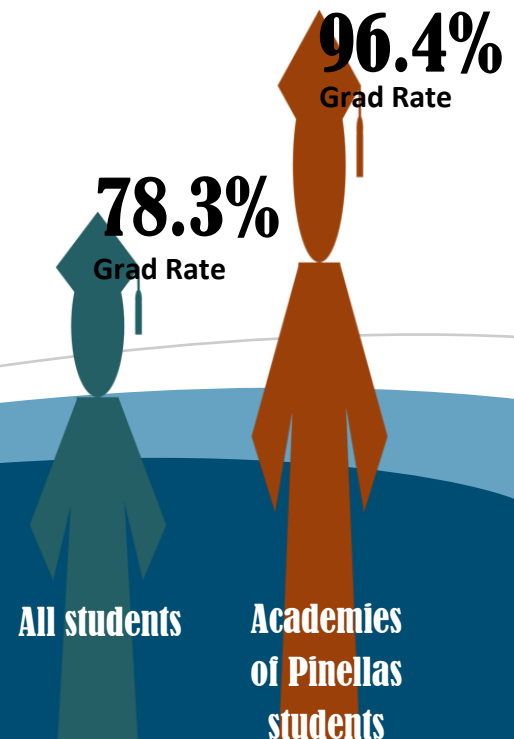

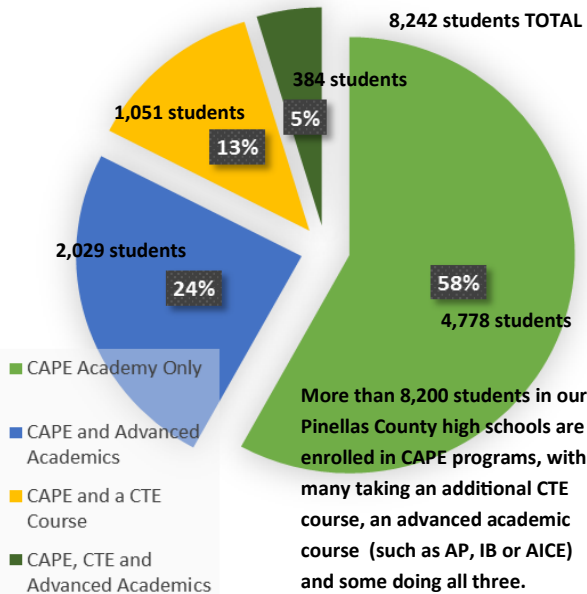
Innovative Solutions

- ◆ Pinellas County Schools has provided a dramatic increase in funds to expand Extended Learning Programs and Summer Bridge offerings to provide all students more opportunities to stay on track.
- ◆ The addition of Career / Technical Programs in our middle schools and high schools are part of a district-wide effort to provide hands-on, applied learning opportunities for our students.
- ◆ Pinellas County Schools has designed a school-by-school graduation report that tracks every student in middle school and high school and their progress in meeting graduation requirements.
- ◆ 52% of all high school students participate in a career academy, advanced academic program or career-technical course/program. Students who enroll in a full career-technical program of study graduate at a rate that is 20% higher than non-program graduates.

- ◆ Pinellas County was named by the Ford Foundation as a Ford Next Generation Model Learning Community, joining Nashville, Tennessee, as the only two school districts in the nation with this prestigious distinction.
- ◆ The Pinellas Education Foundation is considered a national model for business, education partnerships and will manage the Ford NGL conferences.

Innovative Solutions

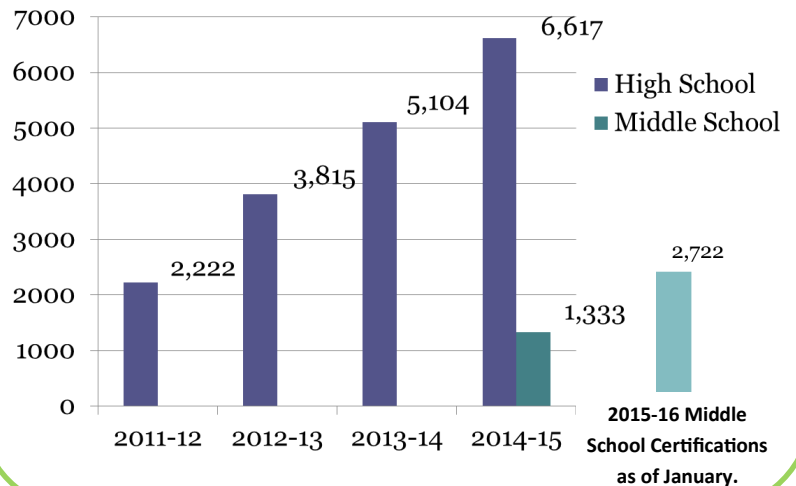

Industry Certifications

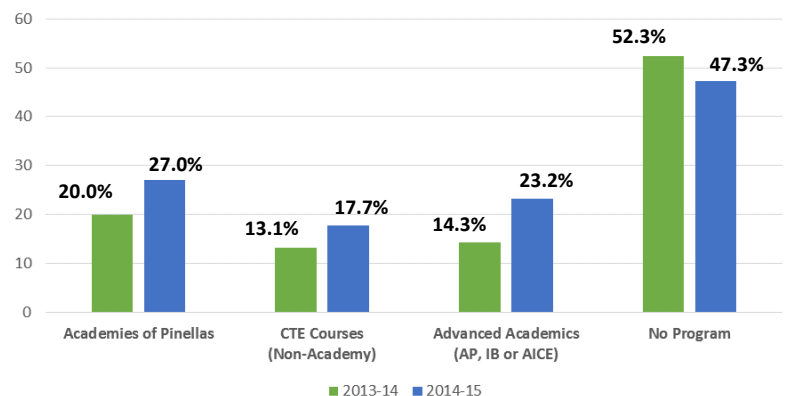
10,000
