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About


A truly unique high school experience as this is a full District Application Program (DAP) school offering career program options. Our student community is limited to just over 600 students. Students graduate with both a high school diploma and industry certifications. Tech High has the highest quality instructors who utilize project-based learning.

The campus has a park like setting with a common area where our students gather at lunchtime to enjoy volleyball, corn-hole, toss a football or frisbee. Tutoring is offered daily.

- In 2018 we became a full-time high school.

CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGIES




The construction industry is booming with over 5% growth each year and not enough workers to meet the demand. In this program, students gain knowledge in reading blueprints and detailed drawings, perform construction mathematics and train in carpentry, electricity, masonry, and plumbing. By the time you finish at Tech High, you will have volunteered with **Habitat for Humanity** and gained the knowledge to obtain the National Center for Construction Education & Research (NCCER) and OSHA certifications.

The demand for electricians is increasing with each passing year. You will be prepared for the commercial and residential need of electricians when you finish at Tech High. In our learning lab, you will have hands-on experiences with wiring, troubleshooting and repair. Enhance your resume by competing in student competitions. In addition to the opportunity to obtain the National Center for Construction Education & Research (NCCER) and OSHA certifications, you will also work in the real world by working with **Habitat for Humanity** and other organizations.


GAMING & SIMULATION PROGRAMMING



Put your passion for video games to work by learning about opportunities in the Information Technology industry. You will complete rigorous project-based activities like creating single and multi-player games, UI design, computer programming and business documentation. Be continuously challenged while creating mobile apps and PC games using Unity (C#), Android Studio and Visual Studio. Amplify your resume by earning industry certifications in Unity, Adobe products or become a Microsoft Technology Associate.

Love working with engines? In the classroom and workshop, you will work with in-board and outboard engines as you navigate the marine repair industry. The Marine Mechanics program will offer precise training in boat engine mechanics, troubleshooting, electrical systems and other aspects of boat repair so you are ready for an entry-level position when you graduate. Students may earn Marine Mechanics certification.

NURSING



The demand for qualified nurses increases daily. Our students learn in the classroom and nursing lab before taking their skills to a healthcare facility where they will provide direct patient care. All students will have the opportunity to obtain their EKG Technician Certification and advanced students are eligible to sit for the Licensed Practical Nursing certification (LPN) NCLEX Licensing Exam upon successful completion of the program. Certifications include American Heart Association: BLS for Healthcare Providers CPR, Bloodborne Pathogens and First Aid.

Make the world smile through the wag of a tail! Your love for animals and their care are enhanced with the Vet Science program. Work directly with small and large animals on our farm like setting - cattle, goats, horses, pigs, rabbits and birds. You will learn to care for these animals by learning anatomy, disease prevention, surgical assisting and grooming. After your internship at a local animal hospital, you can earn your certification as a veterinary assistant with the Florida Veterinary Medical Association. Additionally, you can participate in the FFA and compete in events at the Florida State Fair.
