Sound Detective: Make sounds with household items (e.g. spoon, keys) behind a curtain. Guess the sound and describe how it travels.

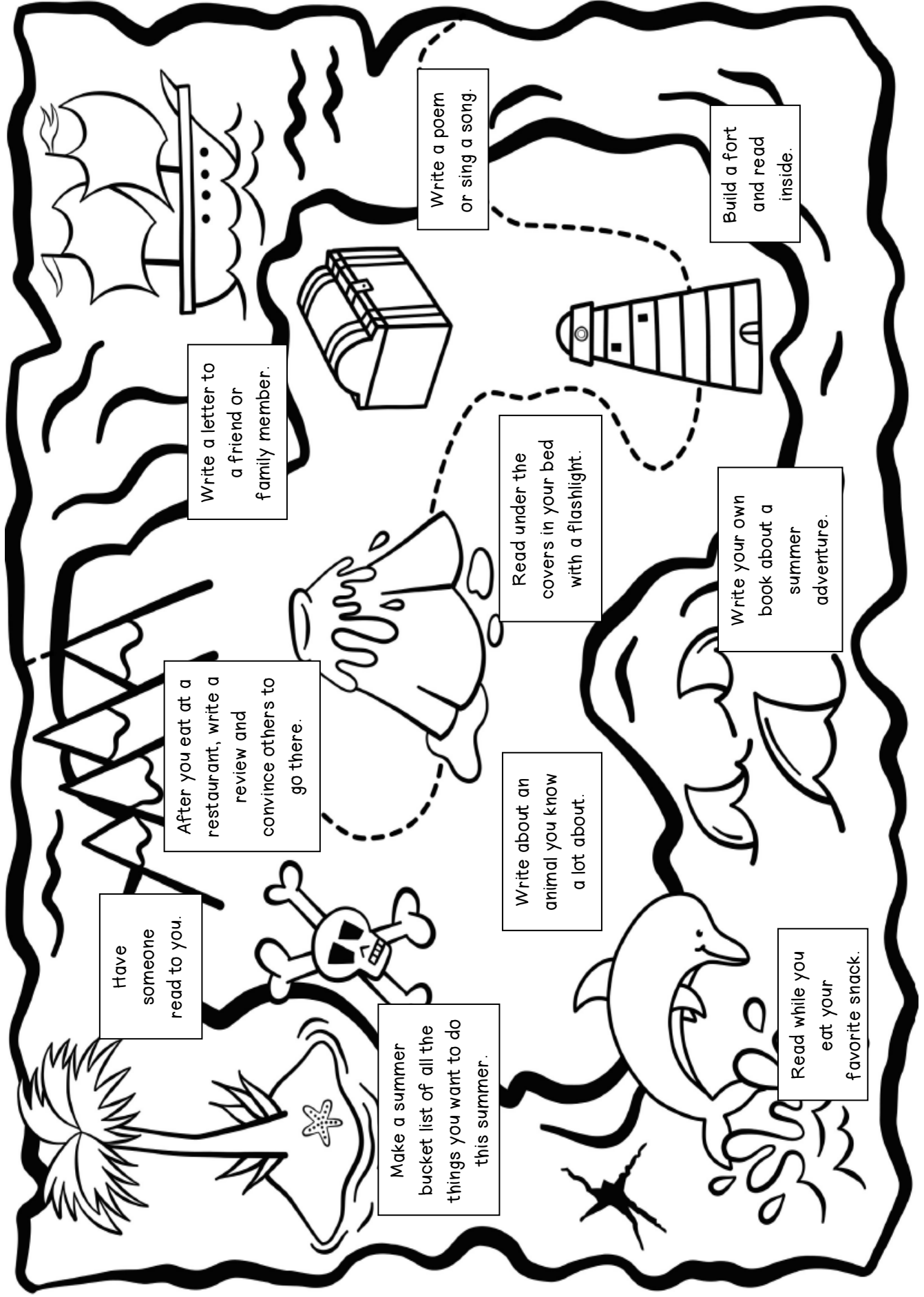
Nature Object Sort: Collect and sort leaves, rocks, or shells by texture, color, or size. Create a collage.

Go on a scavenger hunt and look for shapes outside.

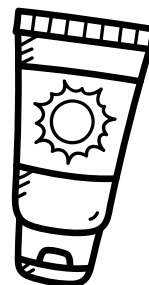
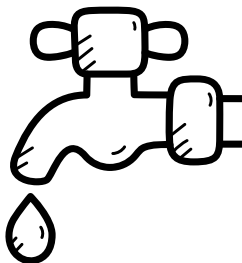
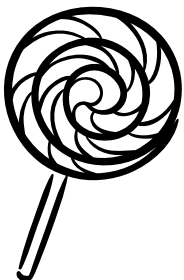
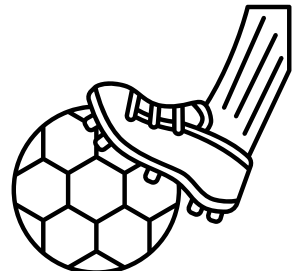
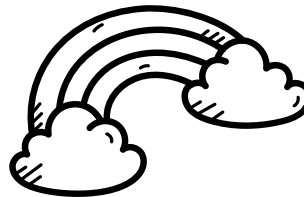
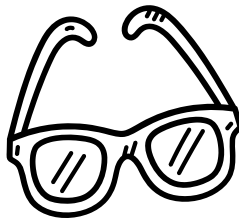
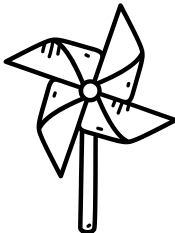
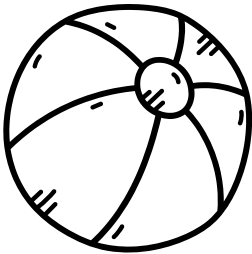
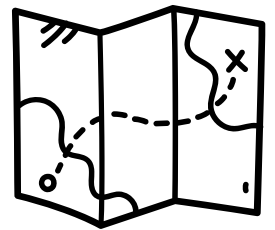
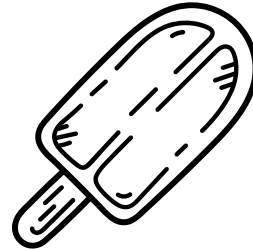
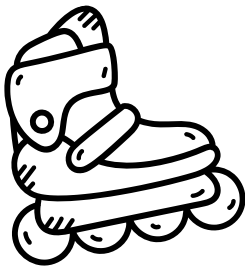
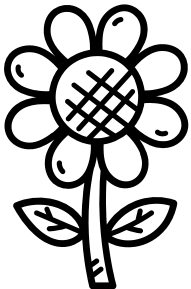
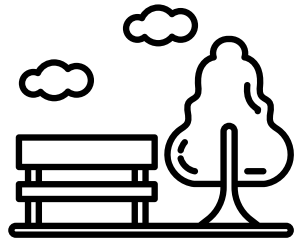
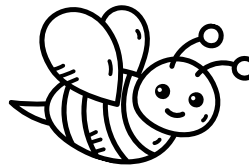
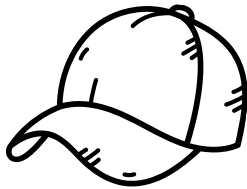
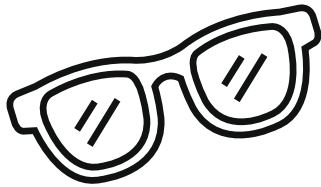
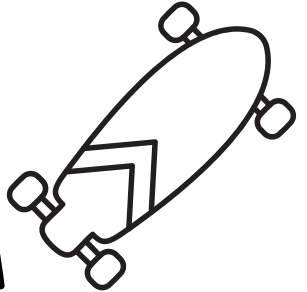
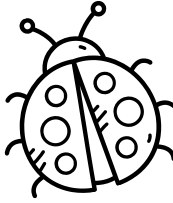
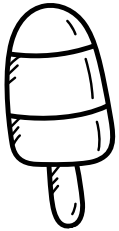
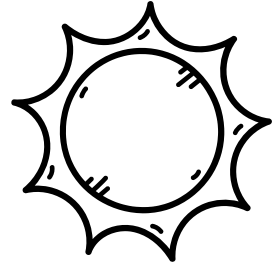
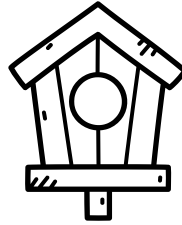
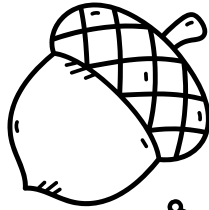
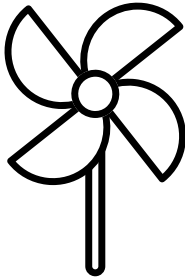
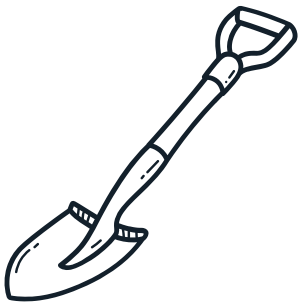
