SCHOOL SAFETY

To ensure the safety of all, we ask that you adhere to the follow safety protocols:

- Attention PreK parents: If you arrive after 2:55pm to pick up your child, you will need to summon an adult at the car circle to get your child. Please DO NOT just walk on campus.
- Please DO NOT drop students off prior to 8:15 and leave them unattended. Supervision starts at 8:15 a.m. This is a major safety issue.
- <u>Late students must be signed into the front office by</u> an adult. Please don't drop late students off in front of the school after school has started.
- No walkup permitted in the car circle at dismissal. Our car circle will <u>ONLY</u> be used by car riders.
- Please use the identified crosswalks when coming on campus.
- Visitors must enter through the front office when visiting our campus. Please have identification on you+at all times.
- Parents please be sure that your student is wearing the proper footwear to school. Crocs and slides are not permitted.

- Our Extended Learning Program (ELP) resumes this week. The Principal's Success Squad tutoring has been adjusted to meet the needs of all students. We also have some new participants. If your child participates, please be sure to remind them to stay after school.
- Enrichment Cycle 3 begins this week! Club assignments will go home on Monday. Only those students with an assignment will be permitted to participate.
- Parents, please be cognizant of what your student brings to school. Please remember that toys are not a part of school supplies and should remain at home.
- Parents, student attendance matters!!! Students are expected to be in their classrooms, in their seats at the 8:45 bell.

 Students arriving after 8:45 will be marked tardy. Gates open at 8:15a.m. If your student is going to be absent, please notify us by calling in at 727-893-1815 or going to our website to report the absence.
