- <u>Please DO NOT drop students off prior to 8:15 and leave</u> <u>them unattended. Supervision starts at 8:15 a.m. This is</u> <u>a major safety issue.</u>
- No walkup permitted in the car circle at dismissal. Our car circle will <u>ONLY</u> be used by car riders.
- For the safety of all, please use the identified crosswalks when coming on campus.
- Visitors must enter through the front office when * *
 visiting our campus. Please have identification on you at
 all times.
- Parents please be sure that your student is wearing the proper footwear to school. Crocs and slides are not permitted.
