SCHOOL SAFETY

To ensure the safety of all, we ask that you adhere to the following safety protocols:

- Please do not drop students off in the street. This is very unsafe.
- School starts promptly at 8:45. Students should be in their seats at this time. Our gates will be closed at 8:45.
- <u>Late students must be signed into the front office by</u> an adult. Please don't drop late students off in front of the school after school has started.
- <u>Please DO NOT drop students off prior to 8:15 and leave</u> them unattended. <u>Supervision starts at 8:15 a.m. This is</u> <u>a major safety issue.</u>
- No walkup permitted in the car circle at dismissal. Our car circle will ONLY be used by car riders.
- For the safety of all, please use the identified crosswalks when coming on campus.
- Visitors must enter through the front office when visiting our campus. Please have identification on yourat all times.
- Parents please be sure that your student is wearing the proper footwear to school. Crocs and slides are not permitted.



NEWS YOU CAN USE...

- Attention Parents, field trip chaperones must be registered volunteers that are assigned to attend the trip through our
 volunteer coordinator. This includes field trips to public places. Parents that just show up at public places without being
 assigned to the trip, will not be able to interact with students. If you have any questions about chaperoning field trips,
 please speak with Mrs. Sanders, our volunteer coordinator. Thank you in advance for following established PCS processes.
- Please be cognizant that your student is in dress code each day. We are seeing more and more students that are out of code (clothing and shoes). Students out of dress code will be sent to the office to get a change of clothes, which may include a call home to get these items exchanged.
- Friendly reminder, enrichment ends promptly at 4:30. Students picked up late will be excused from the program.
- Parent volunteers can host enrichment clubs, as long as they are registered volunteers (Level 2). If you are interested in hosting a club, please notify Ms. Dixon.
- Attention parents, Fridays are designated as House Day. Students that have on their house shirt will receive an extra PBIS point. Please remind your student to show their house spirit on each Friday.
