SCHOOL SAFETY

To ensure the safety of all, we ask that you adhere to the following safety protocols:

- Please do not drop students off in the street. This is veru unsafe.
- The car circle is the safest and the only space that we will facilitate loading and unloading of our students.
 Please use the car line for safe arrival and departure.
- School starts promptly at 8:45. Students should be in their seats at this time. Our gates will be closed at 8:45.
- <u>Late students must be signed into the front office by</u> an adult. Please don't drop late students off in front of the school after school has started.
- Please DO NOT drop students off prior to 8:15 and leave them unattended. Supervision starts at 8:15 a.m. This is a major safety issue.
- For the safety of all, please use the identified crosswalks when coming on campus.
- Visitors must enter through the front office when visiting our campus. Please have identification on you at all times.
- Parents please be sure that your student is wearing the proper footwear to school. Crocs and slides are not permitted, on any day.

- ATTENTION PARENTS: The bus gate on 13th Avenue North is for BUS RIDERS AND WALKERS ONLY. Walkers are those students that walk from the school to their home. Our neighbors are not very happy about those parents that try to avoid the car line and illegally park in front of their homes. Police have gotten involved, and citations are being written. Please avoid the hassle bu using the car line. It's the safest method. We will not be sending students to parked cars, as this is a major safety concern and liability. Thank you for understanding that safety is a priority at Mt. Vernon.
- Please be cognizant that your student is in dress code each day. We are seeing more and more students that are out of code (clothing and shoes). Students out of dress code will be sent to the office to get a change of clothes, which may include a call home to get these items exchanged.
- Attention parents, Fridays are designated as House Day, Students that have on their house shirt will receive an extra PBIS point. Please remind your student to show their house spirit on each Friday.



Please encourage your students to keep our campus safe by reporting anything that they see or hear that can jeopardize the safety of our campus. Thank you for your support of keeping out campus safe.
