Welcome back! We are looking forward to a great school year.

Here is some information that will help you start the new school year:

Modified Dress Code Policy

Shirts

Solid colored, collared polo-style shirt in light blue, navy blue, or red. Shirts should be free from design or logos greater than a quarter. Mildred Helms school spirit shirts may be worn on Fridays.

Bottoms

Khaki or navy colored uniform bottoms. This includes shorts, pants, capris, skorts, skirts, jumpers (shorts must be worn underneath skirts/jumpers). Shorts should follow Pinellas County dress code of mid-thigh length or longer. *Leggings must match the color of the jumper or skirt being worn.*

Closed toed shoes should be worn.

Length of garments, outerwear, and footwear must follow Pinellas County dress code.

Hats, jacket/sweatshirt hoods, and decorative headbands may not be worn in the classroom or common areas of the campus. Hats MAY be worn at P.E.

All students must adhere to the requirements of the modified dress code policy.

Car Circle Info

- Remain in your car at all times. Staff and safety patrols will assist students at curbside drop-off and pickup.
